Kennel Sizing_Chart for Dogs and Cats

$\mathbf{A}=$ Length of animal from nose to root of tail
$\mathbf{B}=$ Height from ground to elbow joint
$\mathbf{C}=$ Width across shoulders
$\mathbf{D}=$ Height of animal in a natural standing position from the top of the head or the ear tip, whichever is higher.
Note: Your pet's head or ear tips, whichever are higher, must not touch the top of the kennel.

## How to Determine Kennel Size

For Domestic travel within the continental United States:

$$
\text { Length = A + } 1 / 2 \mathrm{~B} ; \text { Width = C x2; Height = D + } 1 \text { " }
$$

For International travel and travel outside of the continental United States:
Length = A + B; Width = C + 1" x 2; Height = D + 3"
